JH reported that Membership situation was unchanged from that reported at AGM.

Treasurer's Report: Report to 31st October 2012

Financial position

There has been no change in the financial position since that reported to the AGM, i.e. no surplus or deficit to date, with balances still at £1,716.

Financial forecast for 2012/13

An attempt to forecast possible income and expenditure has been made and details are shown in the Income & Expenditure statement below (Column 2). It will be recalled that if an Audax event produces a surplus the organiser is entitled to decide if some or all of any surplus should be made available to a charity or to RCTC, unless the RCTCs financial position is such that it requires the funds to be retained.

If the assumptions made in the forecast Income & Expenditure statement hold good then the RCTC could expect an overall surplus for the current year – possibly around £200 – and continue to permit event organisers to make their own decisions regarding the destination of any surplus on their event. Such surpluses should continue to be paid to RCTC, and accounted for by RCTC. Any charitable donations requested by the event organisers will then be

made in the name of RCTC which underwrites the events. If financial forecasts prove optimistic there are adequate balances to meet any reasonable deficit for the year.

It should be noted that the forecast provides a budget of £100 to meet any possible cycling promotion events. This could be increased if the Committee so wished.

It is suggested that the charitable donations already approved, or forecast to be available, from event surpluses during 2011/12 (see the Creditors note at the foot of the Balance Sheet, below) be held until any actual surpluses (or deficits) from the Hilly Hundred Audax, the SOOT off-road event and the Upper Thames Audax (2012/13) are known. A final decision on the amounts to be donated, including any 'top-up' agreed by the Committee can be made once these figures are available.
