## Financial position

The only change to the financial position since that reported to the November Committee is the payment for the mulled wine and mince pies event in December 2012. This means that there is a small deficit of £11 for the year to date, with balances now amounting to £1,706.

#### Financial forecast for 2012/13

Final figures for the Upper Thames Audax are not yet available but the organiser has forecast a surplus of around £80, which will be made available to RCTC for donation to the Air Ambulance. The surplus is lower than forecast due to additional costs related to changes in running the event.

However, the Membership Contribution from the National CTC Office should still enable us to break-even at the year-end or make a small surplus of up to £100, if the present assumptions hold good.

Bearing this in mind it is suggested that the sums currently held for donations to charities should be released after rounding up the donations from RCTC balances. This would mean the use of £79.45 from balances, giving donations totalling £500, sourced from last year's Audax events, together with a possible surplus from this year's Upper Thames Audax. Details of the source of these funds are shown in the table below. If the Surplus from the Upper Thames Audax differs from the forecast, or does not materialise at all, the charge to our balance will be greater but can easily be accommodated:
