#### 12. Webmaster Report (AI)

- 12.1 Al advised an obsolescence issue with the website. The framework and content management system we are using cannot currently be updated to the latest version on its current host because the underlying programming language that is available on the host is at version 5.4.45 whereas Wordpress now requires at least v5.6.20 and recommends v7.3. There are two options to resolve:
- a) migrating the sphinx account to a more standardised shared host as these have at least PHP7.0.

b) creating a new account on our more standardised shared hosts at extra cost

Committee agreed with Al's proposal to adopt Option a) with the same hosing company, Mythic Beasts. As always there is a risk of things going wrong during a migration so timing to minimise any disruption. Noted that runs database is separate so not at risk.
