5.2 HSBC looking to introduce a £60/year charge. . Free banking options to be investigated. – Co-Op Bank suggested as a good alternative, though fear is that they may all move to a monthly charge sooner or later

5.3 Funds from Cycling Events: Question raised at AGM Club 2011 constitution required funds to go through club accounts but this isnt. Clarification in 2011 AGM minutes required the funds to be used for charitable purposes with organiser gaining committee agreement beforehand. AGM 2011 recommendation was that that income should go to Reading CTC where there is an identified need or if not a registered charity. Mike provided CUK HQ current policy which implied that all funds should pass through CUK Reading accounts. Committee agreed that this is impracticable from a workload perspective, and also that it would affect organisers ability to secure matching contributions from companies who have supported recent events (eg. Tribute Audax). An option to run events entirely seperately from CUK would remove the publicity benefit and was discounted. Committee decision made that the event organiser submit a summary of accounts to CUK Reading Treasurer after the event This would then be subject to a more detailed check if required at the discretion of the Treasurer. Action: Event organisers to be made aware of requirement to submit summary of accounts within 1 month of the event
